 - c. Westchester County H.E.R.R.O. program administered by the Department of Emergency Services. Volunteers are eligible for up to \$6,000 annually in tuition reimbursement or student loan repayment assistance
 - d. Independent Insurance Agents of Westchester County (IIAWC) Volunteer Firefighters Scholarship Foundation
6. Potential to participate in the Length of Service Award Pension (LOSAP) program
7. Possible Fire Company scholarships, dependent of which company you join within the Tarrytown Fire Department.
 - a. The Student must submit their GPA and maintain or improve their GPA to be eligible
 - b. The Student must have passed NYS Firefighter 1, i.e. completed their probationary period
